Music Ministry:

Chapel Choir—rehearsal Sunday nights at 6:30 for special music during Sunday church services, holidays, and special occasions; all ages welcome

Cantor/Praise Singer—at direction of worship director, leads singing with congregation

Tech & Sound Booth Assistant—at direction of Tech Team, provides information on screens for church services, runs cameras and live streaming

Instrument musician/brass player—at direction of worship director provides special music

Worship:

Worship Team: Meets as needed as the creative worship planning group responsible for services including special hold day worship

Assisting Minister—leads congregation in prayers

Altar Guild—prepares the Altar area with paraments as needed (candles, banners, care of sanctuary

Communion Preparer/Bread Bakers prepares unleavened bread for communion, sets out wine/juice

Lectors—reads provided Scriptures for the service

Hospitality Ministries:

Usher/Greeter-- greets worshipers, provides bulletins and other information for services; collects offering, directs church members to communion, invites visitors to coffee

Coffee Fellowship Hour Servers-every Sunday, prepare coffee and lemonade, serve donuts, clean up

Education Ministry:

Sunday School Teachers—at direction of Sunday School Superintendent, teaches class Sunday mornings

Bible Studies—fellowship opportunities Wed, 6:30 am at Montana Jacks; 10:00 am at church; Hope Circle 9:30am the 3rd Thursday of the month; Men's Square, 6am first Friday of month at church

Vacation Bible School Helpers- early June; leaders for children, preschool room teachers, making/serving snacks, helping with games, singing, registration, decorations and clean up

Youth & Education Committee—meet once a month to create opportunities that enrich the youth and families through experiences that provide faith education, spiritual growth, and nurture congregation, family, and intergenerational relationships

Caring Ministries:

Handyman Ministry—yearly sprinkler blow-out and small repair jobs

Family Promise-provides meals, hosts supper, stay overnight in private room, for families who are without housing and working with FP case managers in program

CARE Team--short term needs of meals, transportation for members

WyndStone Volunteer—lead devotions; assist with Monday afternoon worship; call BINGO; other opportunities by contacting WyndStone volunteer coordinator

Friendship Club—meets monthly the first Wednesday, for fellowship, potluck lunch, and occasional programs

Transportation to Worship—drives WyndStone residents and others to church on Sundays

Funeral Luncheon Volunteers—serves lunches or desserts as needed after services

Other:

Mowing Team—five teams of 4-5 individuals rotate weekly to mow campus grounds

Snow removal Team—using snow blowers, shovels, remove snow on sidewalks when needed

Property Committee—provides maintenance on church grounds & buildings; meets monthly to plan projects

Evangelism Committee—coordinates activities to encourage member participation, and community service projects

Quilting—meets Tuesdays in Jerusalem Room to make quilts

Stitches & scriptures—meets Sunday evenings for fellowship and to knit or crochet prayer shawls

Outdoor Ministry—plans group activities that include camping, games, archery

Adopt-a-Plot/Landscaping—keeps identified areas around campus free from weeds

Stewardship Committee—plans annual efforts for members to take part in ministries of ALC

WELCA--Women of the ELCA. Meets monthly to plan events. Ongoing Quilting every Tuesday, annual Bazaar, lefse making, blood drives, social events, community service events, annual plant sale

Nursery Attendant—care for children during church services on Sunday mornings
